1. A 2 page CV of your employment history, most recent job first, detailing:-

- Organisation
- Dates of employment
- Type of business
- Your role / job title
- Any leadership / budgetary responsibilities

2. A 2 page covering letter detailing:-

- Why you are interested in becoming a MAF Trustee
- What specific expertise you would bring to MAF
- Your local church attendance / membership

- Any role or responsibilities within your local church
- Any overseas or multicultural experience
- Membership of any other boards
- Any Higher education and professional qualifications
- Any voluntary or pro-bono work

3. References, name, job title, email and phone contact details for:-

- Current church minister or senior leader
- A professional peer or senior

References will be taken up for candidates invited to the 2nd stage of recruitment. You will be informed prior to this taking place.

Interviews would normally be held at the MAF UK offices in Folkestone, Kent. However, in the current circumstances initial interviews are likely to be via Zoom.
