We had a great time celebrating Easter here in Kampala. Our church joined with other churches from across Kampala for a joint Good Friday service, and then on Easter Monday we had a church picnic in the garden of one of the families that attend our church. It was a really lovely time and a great reminder that Gods family consists of every tribe and tongue. We enjoyed celebrating with our brothers and sisters from Uganda, Rwanda, DRC, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Germany, The Netherlands, USA and the UK. Kampala is a very multi-national city!

This week we have decided to take a bit of time off work because the kids are on their Easter school break, but also because the first few months of 2024 have been a very full-on time for us as a family!

As some of you will know, if you're part of our WhatsApp prayer support group, we have just moved house, which has been a huge blessing! However, shortly after we moved house, Steph had to go into hospital for an operation to have a cyst removed that was causing here pain. This obviously caused us a bit of nervousness, with no prior experience of the Ugandan health care system, we weren't sure what to expect, but after consulting with medical experts in Uganda and back in the UK, we were re-assured that the procedure could be done here in Uganda with minimal risk. Thankfully, everything went well, and although Steph still has a bit of pain she is recovering well!

Our new house, which is located about a mile away from our old house, has been a real blessing! The house we were living in originally was having a hotel constructed next door, which along with being very noisy and having builders constantly watching everything we did, meant that we would always have a lot of windows looking into our compound. MAF deemed that it wasn't good from a security perspective so they decided to move us.

As our new house is located on one of the hills overlooking Kampala, we have a beautiful view from our garden.

In the MAF Uganda hangar we have been very busy over the last few weeks with lots of maintenance being done to keep our aircraft flying!

We work closely with the MAF US team that operates aircraft in East DRC and recently we have been able to help them with an engine change and some structural repairs on one of their aircraft

I have also recently finished a project to install a new engine monitoring instrument and a fuel flow transducer in our Cessna 206, which will allow our pilots to more closely monitor their fuel consumption and engine performance allowing them to better plan their flights.
