Tomorrow (Wednesday 17th), we are headed to All Nations Christian College (ANCC) in Hertfordshire, UK. We will be there for a little under 3 months studying ANCC's intense Enroute course. The purpose of Enroute is to give us a broad range of Bible and cross cultural training that will be useful in Arnhem Land, and any further countries we will serve in with MAF. We are really looking forward to our time there, and we are excited that there will be several other MAF families on the course with us. During this period, we also plan on speaking at several of our supporting churches, and continue the necessary preparation for our deployment to Arnhem Land in October.

How can you pray for us?

Praise God for all that has happened to get us on our way to Arnhem Land. Continue to pray for a smooth transition over the coming months as we leave the UK/USA.

Praise God that Danielle has obtained some practical Doula hours, please pray that more doors will open for her to get the remainder she needs. Update on Finances

Thank you to all that have supported us through prayer and through giving. For most people this is the end of the financial year and so we wanted to update you on our financial situation too. Last year (Dec 2023) we met our MAF target of £21,500 which was so encouraging, this year the figure increases to £25,000, and this will be the set figure we continue to raise each year with MAF. We are currently a little short of this number as we project where we will finish out at the end of this year (Dec 2024), by approximately £2,000.
